### Project Brief

The unique Zanzibar Club in the heart of Dublin has been designed and constructed with a true eastern style ambience in mind. The bar has a feeling of opulence and indulgence generated directly through the choice of decor; plush velvet cushions, oversized urns and an impressive collection of eastern paintings. The airy and spacious bar is built on two levels and is able to accommodate 1,500 people.

### Solution

TileStyle was asked by the owner Liam O'Dwyer to create a distinct floor scheme keeping in character with the club's overall eastern theme. After much discussion and research, the floor was given a Moorish influence, and plans were finalised following a visit to Seville in Spain. The choice of PDF Italian marble floor tiles in conjunction with glass and marble mosaics blended in seamlessly with the existing eastern decor. The marble tiles were secured with a range of adhesives and grouts from the tiling product portfolio of Weber. The club will sustain heavy pedestrian traffic over a sustained period, in this respect, the choice of appropriate floor tiles and the correct application of them was an essential factor in complying with the Class 5 Ceramic Floor Tile Classification as set out by The Tile Association. The adhesives and grouts specified by Weber for the scheme ensured a professional application was achieved which met the criteria.
